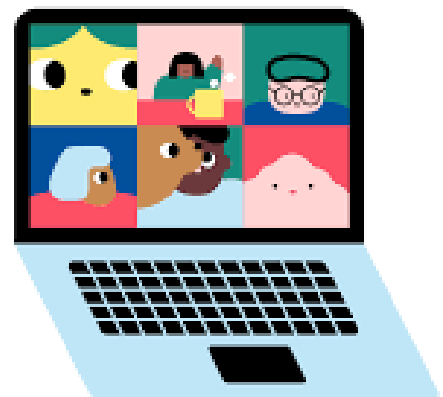

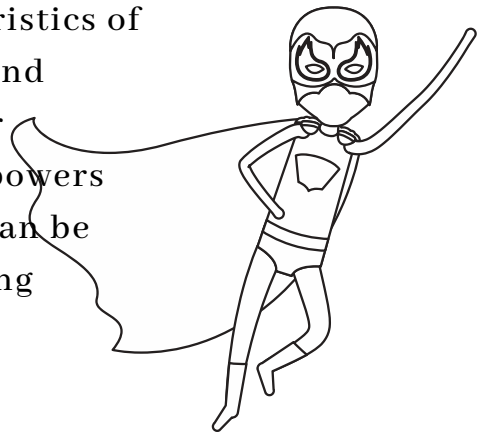


Calling All Superheroes
